



## The Kabbalah

The study of the Kabbalah is to study the universe and its different dimensions and energy. The Kabbalah relates to the macrocosm and the microcosm within each of us. The Sephiroths (spheres or dimensions) also relate internally to the human being, and the different modes of energy that flow through the universe. We need to work with gnostic esoteric exercises to transform energies within us, to become more spiritualised so that we have consciousness of the etheric, astral and mental planes and parallel dimensions.

The timeless Kabbalah is a map given to humanity by the Gods that directs the way to the path of initiation into higher worlds of creation. Samael Aun Weor wrote and lectured extensively on this subject so that Gnostic students can understand the different types of emanations from the divine source or Ain Soph (the absolute). All the different levels of the universe modify the emanations from the Ain Soph that then crystallise within the physical dimension. Through special works we can access the higher more refined emanations that purify and raise the human being to the level of adept or initiate, and finally to mastery.

The esoteric author Dion Fortune writes "Few people, even among those interested in occultism, realise that there is an active esoteric tradition in our midst, handed down in private manuscripts and by 'mouth to ear'. Still fewer know that it is the Holy Kabbalah, the mystic system of Israel, which forms its basis. But where may we look more aptly for our occult inspiration than to the tradition which gave us the Christ?"
